From Niles Congregational Church:

1. Organ – It has a plaque on it with dedications named by donors.
2. Altar – Given in memory of Timothy Vollbrecht
3. Sanctuary doors – Given in memory of Bob Meier
4. Two stained glass windows: One in memory of Mary Goebel
5. Ford Hall ramp in memory of Carol Knight
6. Erickson Table – in memory of Carl Erickson
7. The pianos in the “choir room” and the Guild Room; the electronic keyboards.
8. The Bill O’Donnell Library
9. The kitchen given by Fremont Bank
10. The daycare center named for Grace Draper, Niles School teacher, who started Tri City Volunteers
11. Hymnals
12. Seasonal (especially the newer) banners
13. Bell (in courtyard)
14. Framed Charter of First Congregational Church of Niles (our legal name)
15. Drawings of our church buildings
16. Sanctuary cross

From First Christian Church:

1. Wrought iron chancel pieces (communion table, candle sticks, etc.)
2. Two hand made banners
3. Contents of “Memorial Garden” that are being transferred over.
4. Gold wooden cross
5. Large wooden cross to be constructed from 2 beams from the old church
